Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. This plan has no <u>deductible</u> . Do you need a <u>referral</u> to see a <u>specialist</u> ?	Yes.	This <u>plan</u> will pay some or all of the costs to see a <u>specialist</u> for covered services but only if you have a <u>referral</u> before you see the <u>specialist</u> .
